Our **Dual Recovery Program (DRP)** is a New York State OASAS (Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services) licensed outpatient treatment program that specializes in assisting the recovery efforts of those struggling with substance use and mental illness. Our highly trained, caring, and experienced staff is comprised of credentialed and licensed healthcare and behavioral health care professionals. The DRPs Medical Director is certified by the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM). Our Psychiatrist specializes in adult and adolescent care.

The **DRP** welcomes walk-in assessments Monday through Thursday beginning at 8:00 a.m. for individuals who would like to meet with one of our Intake Specialists. Please note that patients are seen on a first come, first served basis.

Treatment Services

- ◆ The **DRP** uses evidenced based practices such as Stages of Change, Motivational Interviewing, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, and Integrated Dual Diagnosis Treatment.
- ◆ Medically Assisted Therapy (Suboxone/ Vivitrol)
- ◆ Evaluations and assessments for substance abuse and mental health issues
- ◆ Individual counseling
- ◆ Therapeutic groups including, but not limited to: Early Recovery, Relapse Prevention, Managing Recovery, Integrating Recovery, DWI Group, Healthy Alternatives, Men's and Women's Groups, Art Therapy, Healthy Communication, and Recreation Therapy.
- ◆ Adolescent therapy
- ◆ Medication management
- ◆ DWI assessments and treatment
- ◆ Evening appointments
- ◆ Coordination of care with other providers
- ◆ Discharge planning
- ◆ Referrals for appropriate level of care
